

Raffle Rules 2016

This raffle supports the activities of the History Alive Weekend by the Camp Howze MVPA (CHMVPA) and we thank you for your support.

The name printed on the ticket is the winner and cannot be transferred. That is the law.

By purchasing a raffle ticket you attest that you are a law abiding citizen of good moral character, may legally possess the firearm won, agree to use the firearm only in a legal and safe manner, and will, or have already obtained, instruction on the safe use and operation of the firearm won.

The winner must be a citizen of the United States. All Federal and State firearms laws and regulations apply.

The winner must be able to pass a US background check to claim a firearm.

The winner must be 18 years old to claim a rifle.

The CHMVPA makes no warranties regarding any firearms and no representations regarding suitability for any firearm. The CHMVPA is released from any and all associated liability concerning the gun raffle, outside of the cost for tickets purchased.

Raffle is void where prohibited.

It is up to the raffle ticket purchaser to verify that they can legally receive and own their winning firearm where they live. If they cannot legally own their prize firearm, they are automatically disqualified from the raffle, no substitution or other prize to be awarded and no refund will be available. Tickets are non-refundable, including those where a winner's background check fails to pass.

The drawing will be held on September 30th at the KC Hall in Gainesville TX during the Friday Night USO Event 1721 I-35, Gainesville TX 76240.

The drawing is open to the public, but the winner need not be present. All firearm transfers will be done through a Federal Firearms Licensed (FFL) dealer. We have Two Dealers in Whitesboro we can use or you provide your FFL for shipping to. If shipped your responsible for FFL Shipping/Transfer Fees.

Winners will be notified, using the name, address, phone number, and e-mail address that the winner has written on the ticket stub. In the event that CHMVPA is unable to contact the winner it is the sole responsibility for the winning ticket holder to contact CHMVPA to claim their gun.

You have until October 31st, 2016 to work with us to fill out the paperwork to obtain your prize. If you do not do this by then, you forfeit the firearm.

In the event the winner cannot be contacted within 30 days of the drawing, a second drawing will occur. In the event the second winner cannot be contacted within 30 days, subsequent drawings will be conducted until a winner is selected

The CHMVPA makes no warranty of firearms; winners will deal directly with the manufacturer if problems arise. Should any law, regulation or other legal barrier occur before the firearm is awarded, such that the transfer of said firearm is prohibited, the club will award gift cards or a check (at our discretion) for the purchase value of the item. Every attempt will be made to deliver the prize firearm rather than award a gift card or check as a replacement. Any disputes will be resolved by the Board of Directors of CHMVPA, and they have the final say.
